They will work in a fast-paced, interactive office environment to help SLM enhance its ability to serve a growing number of new neighbors and continue to increase Missoula's capacity to be a welcoming community. This position is flexible, with some off-site hours and occasional night and weekend hours.

The Intern will:

- Assist with administrative work
 - Data entry, scanning, using Canva, answering the phone, running errands, and more
- Assist walk in clients
 - Help fill out applications, pay bills, schedule appointments, refine resumes, read emails and mail, and more.
- Help manage in-kind donations
- Help keep an organized office
- Assist in planning and staffing social and educational events

The ideal candidate will:

- Have a passion for refugee resettlement in Missoula
- Be a welcoming, kind person
- Have a proven ability to establish and meet deadlines, multitask, and prioritize
- Have a working knowledge or ability to learn about the Missoula community and resources
- Have the ability to interact positively with a variety of people
- Have the ability to work independently and take initiative to follow through with organizational goals
- Be 18 years of age or older
