



AmeriCorps Team Member Position Description

Overview

2024/2025 school year

Service Term: 300 hours Education Award: \$1,565

450 hours Education Award: \$1,956.35

This position will serve a 300 or 450 hour AmeriCorps service term over the 2024/25 school year with Soft Landing's youth program and earn an education award upon completion of service. AmeriCorps Team Members will have a flexible schedule within programming to fit around other commitments, serving 10-15 hours per week on average depending on service term period. The AmeriCorps summer member will work together with SLM staff and AmeriCorps members to provide free and accessible educational and recreational activities for refugee youth throughout the school year. Members support planning and organization of activities, work with volunteers, provide transportation and logistical support, and interact with and mentor refugee youth. Activities may include recreational activities, college tours, boys group, Girls Leadership Council, middle school after school programming, and homework support for college and high school students.

Responsibilities and Activities:

- Support planning, coordination, transportation, facilitation and implementation of weekly academic programming developed to fit the needs of refugee youth in Missoula.
- Support planning, coordination, transportation, facilitation, and implementation of social programming for refugee youth.
- Support planning and supervision of social, educational, and recreational events and activities to support social and emotional well-being for refugee and immigrant youth in Missoula.
- Attend training sessions and professional development opportunities.

Qualifications and Preferred Skills

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Ability to work well in a team environment
- Passion for community service and making a difference
- Flexibility to adapt to changing project needs
- Valid driver's license, possession of a vehicle, and willingness to provide transportation for participants (mileage reimbursement provided)
